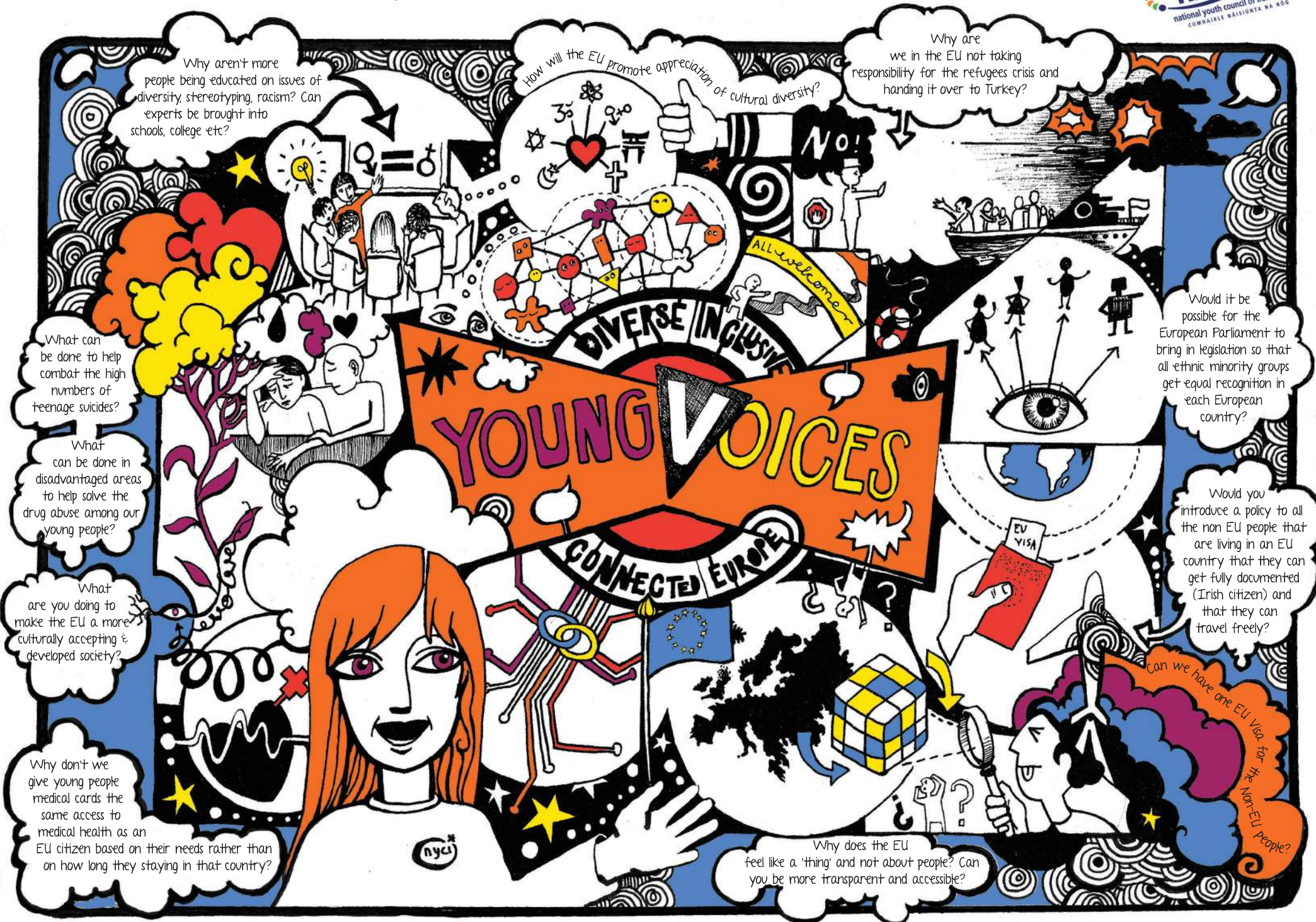


Report on the Structured Dialogue "Young Voices" Event on an Inclusive, Diverse and Connected Europe
